Auxiliū Helenae, quae ex urbe Trojā exīre jam dēsiderābat, Graeci dolum parāvērunt. Magnum equum ligneum instrūxērunt (drew up) in quō numerum virōrum fortium celāvērunt. Noctū ceterī Graeci equum in conspectū (sight) Trojanōrum reliquērunt et ad insulam propinquam discessērunt. Unus ex comitibus, cujus nomen erat Sinon, prope urbem sē celāvit.

Māne Trojanī ex urbe magnō cum gaudiō exiērunt et in castra Graecōrum deserta convēnērunt. Equum spectāverunt. Alii, quī dolum Graecōrum nōn sēnsērunt hunc equum esse, in urbem equum trahere dēsiderāvērunt. Alii, quī autem equum timuērunt, eum delēre dēsiderāvērunt. Rex et magistratūs (officials) denique equum intrā murōs urbis introduxērunt.

Deinde Laocoon, sacerdos, clamāvit, "In equō latet dolus. Timeō Graecōs et dona ferentīs (especially when they are bringing gifts). Statim Laocoon hastam in equum jēcit. Subitō autem duō serpentēs ex marī venērunt et ejus duōs filiōs interfēcērunt.
