5 Dictator in perpetuum creatus Caesār agere insolentius coepit; senatum ad se venientem sedens exceptit et quendam ut assurgeret monentem irato vultu respexit. Ubi Antonius, socius Caesaris in omnibus bellis et tum consulatus collega, capiti eius in sella (chair) aurea sedentis diadema (crown) imposuerat, id ita ab eo repulsum est ut non offensus videretur. Qua re amplius sexaginta viri, Cassio et Bruto ducibus, in eum coniuraverunt (conspired) et constituerunt eum Idibus Martiis in senatu interficere.

10 10 Quamquam haruspex (soothsayer) Spurinna eum monebat ut caveret periculum quod non ultra Martias Idus proferretur, statuit tamen eo die senatum habere. Dum Curiam (Senate) intrat, Spurinnam irrisit, quod sine ulla sua noxa (harm) Idus Martiae adessent. "Venerunt quidem," dixit Spurinna, "sed non abierunt." Caesarem assidentem coniurati (conspirators) specie offici circumsteterunt; unus deinde quasi aliquid rogaturus propius accessit et ab utroque humero togam apprehendit. Deinde ut animadvertisit undique se strictis pugionibus (drawn daggers) peti, toga caput obvolvit (covered) et tribus et viginti plagis (blows) necatus est.
