

# Florida Junior Classical League State Latin Forum

## Creative Project Description Card

Each project at the Forum must have a 3x5 index card attached on the front of it containing the following information:

### Front of Index Card

**Student ID Number** [The four-digit number beginning with 7 on the student's nametag]:

**Project Category & Grade Level** [5-9 or 10-12]:

**Source Material – This information is NOT optional.** Students must indicate the source of any and all material on the project description card for every project category. Students may note on the project description card that their sources are located on their projects or on their project explanation sheet (which is included with the project). Students may cite "original work," if both the project and idea are entirely of the students' making; however, students are strongly encouraged to cite all mythological and historical references – a reminder that failure to cite sources may result in disqualification.

**Description of Project** – This could include a brief description (e.g., one or two sentences) of what the project looks like; the materials used to make the project; anything else of interest about the project that you would like the judges to know, such as how long it took to make, interesting facts, etc.

1. Project cards may be handwritten or typed.
2. Students should consider completing the description card prior to State Latin Forum. Prewritten cards tend to be of higher quality than those written at Forum. Prewritten cards also speed up the project registration process.
3. Blank index cards will be available at the project registration table for those students who have not produced one prior to the Forum.
